1. Contact your Mentor and schedule the three Events:

2. Before the Introductory Class:
 - a. Make ten copies of the Trial Play.
 - b. Complete the Cast List, selecting one of your students to play each of the ten speaking parts.
 - c. Familiarize your class with the Vocabulary List.

3. Before the Courthouse Tour:
 - a. Arrange transportation for your class and chaperones to and from the courthouse.
 - b. Have your Cast Members learn to speak their parts in loud voices.
 - c. Create the Juror Name Cards - Write the names of all students (except the ten with speaking parts) on slips of paper for the juror selection process.
 - d. Collect the Trial Props you are to provide.
 - e. Have your students eat their lunches before leaving for the courthouse.

4. At the Courthouse Tour:
 - a. Bring your Cast List, Verdict Form, and Trial Props.
 - b. Make sure your students conduct themselves properly in the courthouse.

5. Before the Follow-up Class:
 - a. Copy the Elementary Law Certificate and complete one for each student who attended the Courthouse Tour. Have the completed Certificates ready for the Follow-up Class where the Mentor will distribute them.

6. After the Follow-up Class:
 - a. If you have any comments or suggestions regarding the program, please tell your Mentor about them.
